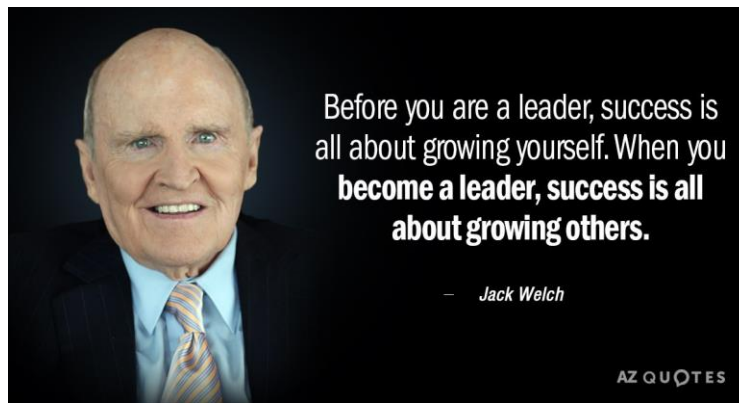
Joke of the Week with Jeff Balzer:

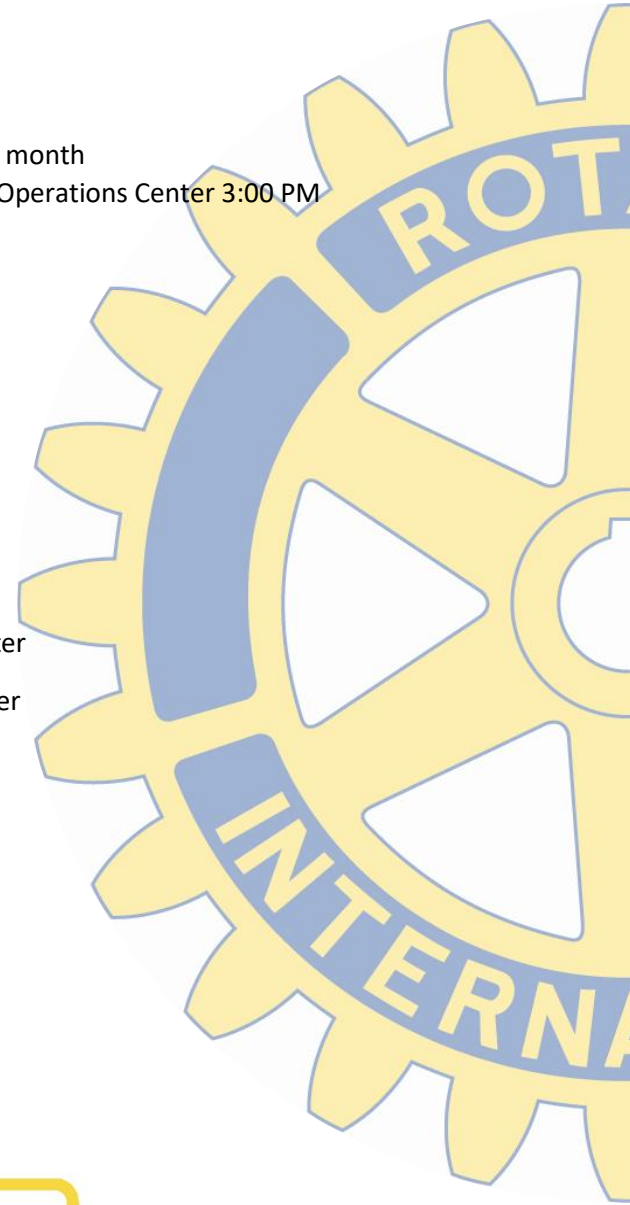
