Mark Barnhart reported 35 of our 63 members were in attendance and 6 guests.

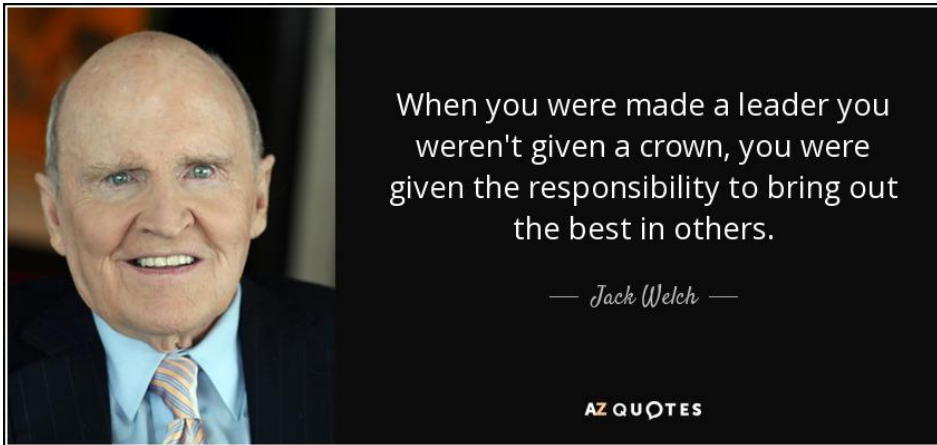
Announcements:

Sartorial

Sartorial comes from the Modern Latin word sartor which means "tailor," literally "one who patches and mends."
