A duck walked into a pharmacy He asked the pharmacist "Do you have any grapes?"

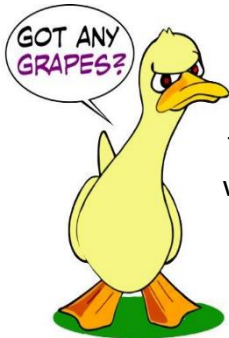
"No, but the grocery store two blocks down sells grapes." he replied.
