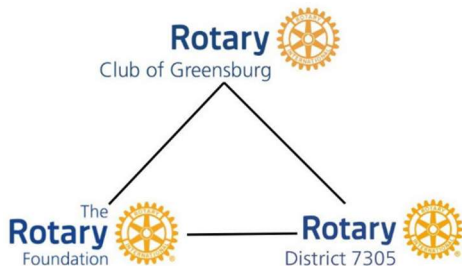
President Al Lazar called the meeting to order & led us in the Pledge of Allegiance

In 1917, the Rotary Foundation began. The Foundation is the charitable Arm of Rotary and is run by Trustees. The beginning funds was a total of \$26.50. \$4,000,000 has gone out from the Rotary Foundation since the beginning to assist people.

The End Polio Now campaign was started in 1987. 3,000,000,000 children have been immunized thru the Rotary Foundation. Previously, our own Chuck Anderson participated in a Nation Immunization Day in India. In 1980, Adid Barsoum and his son were able to utilize one of the Foundation’s Global Grants and collect Medical supplies to send to Kathmandu in Nepal.

For the Greensburg Rotary to receive matching Grant money, we need to donate \$100 per capita. Right now, we are \$17.00 per capita. Funds can be donated thru Mark Barnhart or thru Rotary Direct on the Rotary Foundation website.
