Public Safety consists of First Responder Agencies, Haz Mat, Emergency Management, and the 911 Call Center. They teach to be prepared for any Safety issues, whether it be floods, tornadoes, snowstorms, fires, etc.... 1. Stay Informed 2. Build a Kit 3. Make an Emergency Plan. Suggested Items for the Kit are clothes, food & water, medical information, personal care items, phone charger, important papers, and extra keys. Also, a kit for your Pets: Food and water, leash, blanket, Vet records, carrier, and medication.

Each county in the State of PA is mandated to have a Call Center. Westmoreland County handles over 1,000 calls per day. For early detection, residents can register on the Public Safety Website for CodeRED, it is a free service and address specific to the happenings in your area. Public Safety also works with the Human Services Preparedness Coalition and the Disaster Recovery Case Management. Both the agencies assist in the rebuilding after a tragedy takes place.
