There have not been any defaults with any of the mortgages and the families appear to be thriving. They are working on 2 more homes at this time. These proposed houses will both be 3 Bed/ 2 Bath offerings in Grapeville. They will begin the application process once the homes are completed.

She also spoke about the Restore location in the WOW outlets in Greensburg. They are celebrating their 10th year at this site. Not only do they accept donations but they also partner with companies like Lowe's that will give items they cannot sell in their store. These would include scratch and dents and custom orders that were declined. The Restore can then sell these at very low costs, which helps to fund the CWHH homes. They are open W-Sat from 10-5.

They are always happy to accept volunteers with building the homes, working in the store, committees, fundraising, etc.
