SPEAKER:

Jeff Balzer is talking about his experience as a public adjuster. Public adjusters are insurance claims adjusters who do not work for insurance companies. They work solely for the insured, to assist in the preparation, presentation, and settlement of the claim. Public adjusters are compensated by charging a percentage of the amount they recover from the insurance claim settlement. This percentage can range from 2 percent to 25 percent or more, depending on the size and complexity of the claim. Public adjusters are required to be licensed and bonded. Jeff gave examples of some of the claims that he assisted with recently.
