TODAY'S PROGRAM:

Frank Stillman was our speaker today. He is the VP of the local chapter of the Sons of the Revolution. He explained that the original chapter was created in 1875 in San Francisco. It was timed to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence. The Headquarters are in Louisville, KY where Teddy Roosevelt signed the national charter in 1906. Compatriots, as members are referred to, must have a direct lineage to the Revolutionary War.
