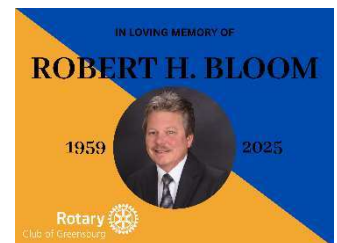
They are having their annual "Walk to end Alzheimer's" on September 19 at Twin Lakes.
