TODAY'S PROGRAM:

Sara Chesler, from CORE, was our speaker today. CORE stands for Center for Organ Recovery. They are one of 57 federally designated not-for-profit organ procurement organizations in the United States. Their Mission statement is “To Save and Heal lives through donation.”

Their Pittsburgh location serves three states, 5 million people and 7 transplant centers.

She talked about the critical need for transplants and used the Acrisure (Heinz) Stadium's capacity to drive home that point. Throughout the USA, only 54% of the available population are registered to donate. It is only 50 % within PA.

She relayed that not everyone who is a designated donor will actually be able to donate upon their demise because there are strict guidelines on who/where/when/how this occurs.
