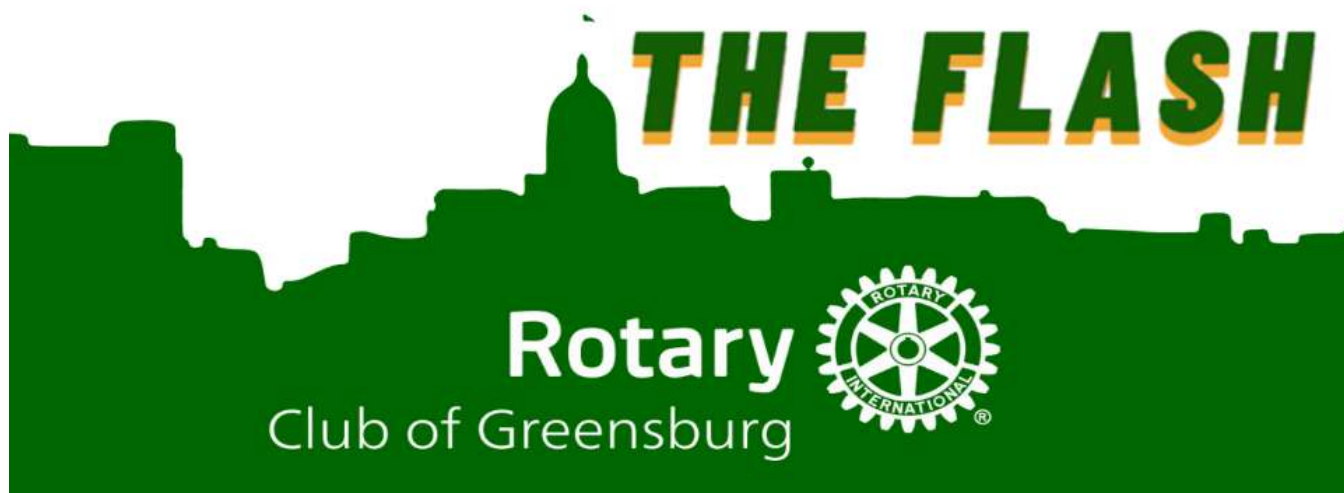




July 14, 2026

TODAY'S PROGRAM:

Michael Storm, the Director Operations Engineered Products at Ebara Elliott Energy, was our speaker today. The Elliott Group, as it was formerly called, celebrated 100 years of history in 2010. In 1914, W.S. Elliott renamed his company Elliott Company and moved his facility to Jeannette, where it remains. Between 1910 and 2000, Elliott Company continued to expand their products and territories. In 2000, Ebara Corporation purchased Elliott and began integrating its operations in Japan and Jeannette. In 2024, the company was rebranded as Ebara Elliott Energy.



With over 1000 employees, 400 of which are U.S. steelworkers, they provide products and/or services for Oil & Gas, Petrochemicals, Power Generation, Refinign, Liquified Natural Gas, Ethylene, Boil Off Gas, Plant Oils, and Sustainability.

Mike stated that their equipment runs 24/7 for 5-7 years. That would be equivalent to driving your car, at 60 mph, to the moon and back for 13 consecutive years. They have the largest test facility in the world.
